We produce an incredibly vast array of wines in Italy. The styles vary enormously, there are hundreds of native grape varieties. So how do we decide who to work with?

Our philosophy is one driven by our Italian roots. We talk with people, visit and understand their approach. Then we taste the wines and see how they might fit into an Irish context. This is neither easy nor quick, but then making good wine isn't either.

Italy grows the largest range of native grapes in the world (more than a quarter of the world's commercial wine grape types).

This variety is the combination of different factors including the diverse terroir, climate and the strong cultural heritage of each region.

Italy's territory spans from the misty lands of Piedmont and Veneto in the north, down to the romantic countryside of Tuscany towards the centre, and then down again towards the turquoise sea and wild mountains of Sicily.

This guide is intended to steer you through the many wines we have available. But as with so many things, you really need to meet us so we can explain in more detail, to show you what we really can do by working with such inspiring people.

PIEMONTE



The home of Barolo and Barbaresco (made using the Nebbiolo grape), Barbera and Dolcetto. The region also offers lighter and sparkling wines like Moscato D'Asti, Brachetto and a beautiful white wine called Gavi made from Cortese grape. Most of the wines of Piedmont come from the Langhe sub-region and its misty hills. The land is overlooked by the Alps, in fact in Italian the name Piedmont means "at the foot of the mountain". The largely red wines are powerful and muscular, but like the Burgundy there is also enormous elegance and finesse in the good producers. The whites are elegant with considerable backbone.



FIGLI LUIGI ODDERO

Figli Luigi Oddero is one of the top producers of Barolo, Barbaresco and Barbera. The winery dates back to the 18th century. Just over half of the 35-hectare Oddero vineyards produce Nebbiolo for Barolos and Barbaresco. These award-winning wines consistently perform well in tastings and with good reason. There is real finesse and depth and a beguiling sense of terroir. These are serious Italian wines that make any list stand out as being prestigious and well-sourced.

LA MESMA

The La Mesma vineyards are located in Monterotondo, at the very heart of the Gavi DOCG region in Italy. The region benefits considerably from coastal influences. Production is on twenty-six hectares of Cortese vines. The Gavi area is rich in biodiversity, with woods surrounding the vineyards and wild animals free to roam. La Mesma, owned and run by three sisters, believes great wine is based on the fruit, obtained with gentle, hands-on farming practices.

LIGURIA



Liguria, in the North West of Italy, is characterised by a particular and unique territory. Facing the Ligurian Sea on the Southern coastal area and surrounded by mountains on the Northern side, Liguria's orography strongly influences the agriculture and viticulture of the region. Since most of the vineyards are located on steep slopes degrading down to the sea, a hard manual work is required and the grape harvest is still carried out by hand, carrying the baskets full of grapes out of the vineyards on the shoulders. This is why the viticulture in Liguria is defined "heroic".



Due to the challenging environment, the focus is on the quality of the wines rather than the quantity. Wines such as Pigato, Vermentino, Rossese and Ormeasco from the *Riviera Ligure di Ponente* are acclaimed and highly appreciated for their unique and distinctive organoleptic properties.

Cascina Praie' and Lupi are part of Peq Agri, a farming and transformation business based in Liguria which is part of the same group as Italicatessen.

CASCINA PRAIE'

Cascina Praie' winery is located in Andora in one of the most beautiful areas of Western Riviera Ligure. This area is characterised by a mild microclimate, where a sea breeze gently blows.

Cascina Praie' produces high quality wines including Pigato, Vermentino, Granaccia and Rossese protected by the appellation Riviera Ligure di Ponente DOC alongside other typical Ligurian wines such as Lumassina IGT delle Colline Savonesi, still produced with the traditional ancestral method.

The vineyards, located in the provinces of Savona and Imperia, are grown with consideration for the soil and the plants, preserving the biodiversity chain within the region.

Lupi winery, located in Pieve di Teco, in the hinterland of Imperia in Ligurian Western Riviera, was founded in the 1960s. Since then, Lupi's main objective has always been the valorisation of the territory and its native vines to produce superior quality wines.

Vermentino "Serre", Pigato "Petraie" and "Vignamare" - a barrique aged Pigato - are highly appreciated and perfectly represent Lupi's winemaking art.

TRENTINO ALTO



Trentino-Alto Adige, in the north of Italy, is surrounded by the Dolomites and Alps, so viticulture is performed on many steep slopes and terraces. Due to the challenging environment, the focus is on quality that makes it worthwhile persisting with the hard work in difficult environmental conditions.

The particular microclimate with its significant daytime temperature variation allows for very aromatic, elegant wines with complexity and freshness. International varieties such as Sauvignon Blanc, Pinot Noir and Pinot Grigio from this area are highly acclaimed alongside Gewurztraminer, Muller Thurgau and native grapes such as Lagrein, Teroldego and Schiava.

ADIGE

LAVIS

LaVis is an Award Winning cooperative, located in the heart of the Trentino wine region. Its origins date back to 1850 when the Cembran family constructed the first part of the winery. Today Lavis agronomists and oenologists identify outstanding vineyards and sites with the best growing conditions.

These high-selected growers cultivate the wines on small individual plots using traditional methods and hand harvesting. Vineyards are located on steep hills as high as 800 meters above sea level, enabling the vines to express their full potential.

LaVis represents a true expression of Trentino's identity, through hard work, innovation and respect for the environment.

VENETO



Veneto, in the north east, is Italy's largest wine producing area and has the greatest concentration of DOC wines. It is the home of Prosecco and of Amarone. Amarone is made using indigenous varieties like Corvina, Molinara and Rondinella in the Valpolicella area, together with Ripasso and Valpolicella.

Another famous area is Soave, made with Garganega together with the less-known but elegant white Lugana. In the small hillside area between the towns of Conegliano and Valdobbiadene lies the Prosecco Superiore DOCG Appellation, where the best quality Prosecco is produced.





S PERI

Valpolicella comes from the Latin words Val Polis Cellae (valley of many cellars). The award winning Speri family began working as vine growers in Valpolicella seven generations ago. After many years of sustainable agriculture, they obtained organic certification in 2015. Speri is an important representative of the wines of the Valpolicella Classica zone and has become a fundamental point of reference within the Italian wine scene.

MARCHE

Located in central Italy where they have been producing wine for centuries. Most common is the white Verdicchio grape but there are a growing number of reds.

The reds do tend to be quite big, but there are gems to be found too. The whites are generally really good with a freshness and acidity that is both modern and welcome.



FORTETO SAN LEO

Verdicchio Classico dei Castelli di Jesi is in the province of Ancona in Central Italy. This zone features fortified villages and gives rise to the Castelli part of the DOC name. "Classico" means that the grapes are grown in the oldest historical wine growing zone around Jesi.

TOSCANA



Sangiovese grapes are abundant in the region and are the main component of Chianti and many of the so-called super Tuscans. Brunello di Montalcino and Vino Nobile di Montepulciano are among the world's most famous wines. While Tuscany is clearly one of the most visited regions of Italy it also has some amazing wines and a very dynamic wine community



TENUTE AMBROGIO E GIOVANNI FOLONARI

The Folonari family has been producing wine since the eighteenth century and marries this tradition with a modern, forward-thinking approach. They produce some of the best wines in Tuscany, the perfect expression of areas best suited to wine production: Chianti Classico, Montalcino, Montepulciano, Bolgheri and Montecucco in Maremma.

THE TENUTA DI NOZZOLE CHIANTI CLASSICO

The estate dates back to 1300. In addition to Pareto, a so-called Super Tuscan, the vineyards also produce Nozzole Chianti Classico, La Forra Chianti Classico Riserva, Le Bruniche Chardonnay and a Vin Santo del Chianti Classico.

ABRUZZO



Abruzzo is located almost directly east from Rome. Native grapes include Pecorino along with Trebbiano and Montepulciano, but Montepulciano d'Abruzzo remains the most famous.

DINO ILLUMINATI

Based near the hilltop village of Controguerra, the Illuminati family produces a range of wines, including the award-winning Riparosso and the Riserva Zanna. The family has been key in raising the profile of Abruzzo wines. The 130 hectares of vineyards are all located in the zones of Controguerra DOC and D.O.C.G. Montepulciano d'Abruzzo Colline Teramane. Located 320 metres above sea level the variations in temperature help in the wine making process.
